How long does it last and how far do we travel?

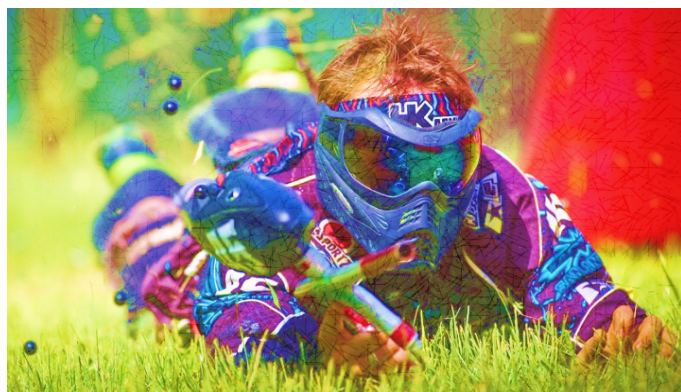
Half-day trip in the afternoon - 30 minutes to Pattaya

How long does it last and how far do we travel?

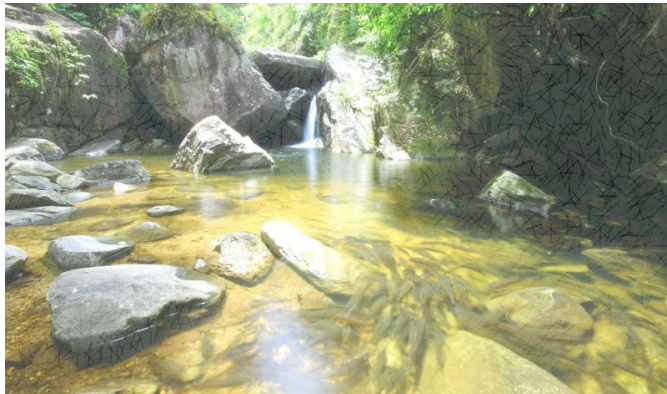
Full day trip – we will return to school for 6pm. Two hours from Pattaya

How long does it last and how far do we travel?

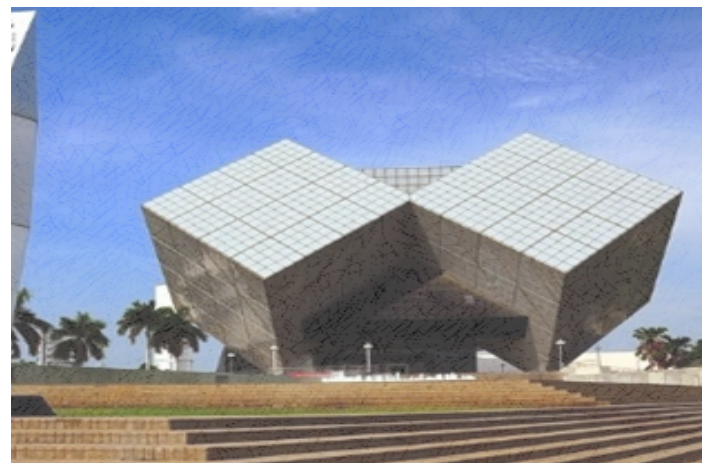
Full day trip – we will return to school for 6pm. 2 hours to Bangkok

How long does it last and how far do we travel?

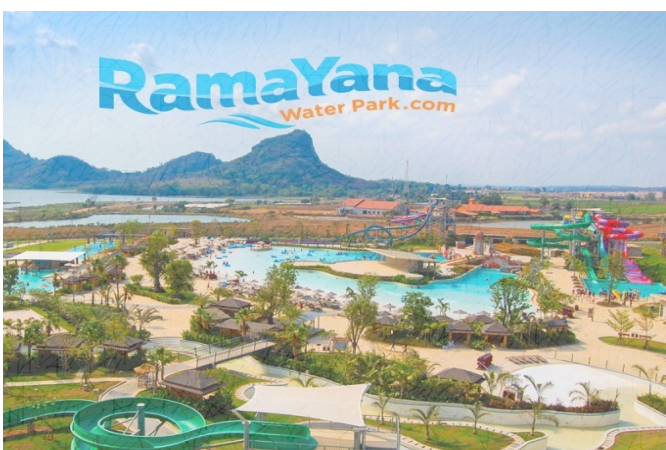
Whole day trip - 30 minutes to Pattaya

How long does it last and how far do we travel?

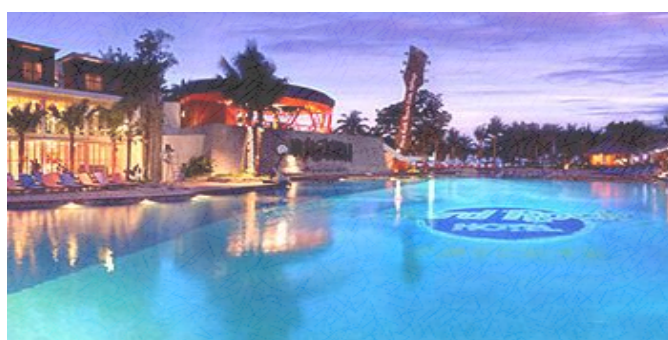

What should I bring?

Packed lunch will be provided but bring some snacks too. Hat, sunscreen, pocket money, camera and preferably your mobile phone.



NOTE: *There is a very* strict dress code for visiting the Grand Palace. The Temple of the Emerald Buddha is Thailand's most sacred site. Visitors must be properly dressed before being allowed entry to the temple. Men must wear long pants and shirts with sleeves -- no shoulderless tops. Women must be similarly very modestly dressed. No see-through clothes, short skirts, bare shoulders, etc. If you wear sandals you must wear socks (in other words, no bare feet). Non-Thai's will not be allowed entry wearing flip-flops – proper shoes are required.
