Create a list of natural disasters that have happened in the past 6 months on the continent of North America.



Explain how a tsunami is formed.



Write instructions explaining what to do if an earthquake were to occur.



Create a working model to show how an earthquake forms.

Main Course – you **MUST** do these every week:

- Read for 15 minutes - 5 times per week
- Learning weekly spellings
- Times table practise
- 15 minutes on Mathematics/Reading Eggs – 3 times per week
- Numeracy – Worksheet x 1
- Literacy – Worksheet x 1

- Everyone **must** finish the main course every week. Work must be completed in your Home Learning books and returned to school on Wednesday of each week.
- Everyone **must** attempt one, or both, of the project deserts. You will be asked to present your work to your teachers and peers.
