

The Regents International Study and English (RISE) Programme has been specially designed for students aged from 14 to 17 who aim to:


- Gain access to the mainstream courses at Regents but who need to improve their English language skills first.

CURRICULUM AREAS ANNOUNCED

With RISE due to launch in August 2014, we are pleased to announce the academic make-up of the programme.

Almost half of all lessons (20 per week) will be devoted to specialist English language tuition. With no more than 8 students to each teacher, the lessons will be suitable for a wide range of learners, from those who have no English to those who have already attained a reasonable standard. Students on RISE will learn to read and respond with thought to a variety of texts, express themselves in English and to write using academic vocabulary.

In addition to English, students on RISE will be able to build a bespoke curriculum based on the following set of subjects:

BOARDING RECEIVES THB 20 MILLION INVESTMENT


Work is now well-underway on a THB 20 million (USD 620,000) refurbishment of the boarding facilities at Regents and will be completed by the middle of August – just in time for the start of the RISE programme. Made-to-measure beds, wardrobes, desks, bedside cabinets and shelving units are being constructed especially for the school.

A series of 'common rooms' or lounges, where the students spend time relaxing together, are being refitted with new kitchens, dining areas and soft furnishings. New televisions, microwaves and fridges in each common room will provide boarders with all their home comforts.
