Literacy

This week we will be using our knowledge of the features of an adventure story to help us write our own new chocolate factory chapter. We will focus on creating a strong ending and including dialogue.

Maths

In Maths the children will be working on solving problems that involving fractions. They will be putting into practice the skills they have learnt last week of adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator and finding equivalent fractions.

Themed Learning

'Chocolate'

The children will be discussing the big questions: "What is fairtrade chocolate? "and "What other products are fairtrade?" They will be talking about the similarities and differences between the lives of cacao farmers and themselves, as well as how people try to make the world more equal. By the end, the children will think about "Is enough being done for cacao farmers? How could we help more?"

PHSCE

The children will be continuing to share their opinions, and explain their views, this week within the context of fairtrade.

There is no homework this week due to the holiday.


Year 3 / 4 Spanish – Ms Sutton
