Starters: Art

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **<u>next week</u>**.

In *Numeracy*, the children will be continuing to revise all the topics for their assessments. We will be looking at measurements, time, multiplication and division. If you require any extra worksheets to practise at home, please let your class teacher know.

In *Literacy*, the children will begin to complete their assessments. They will complete their 'Phonics screening' where they have to read and sound out 40 words. They will also be completing a PM Benchmark assessment which involves them reading a variety of books and answering questions.

In *Science*, the children are going to be continuing revising for their Science assessment. The children will complete short tasks based upon the topics we have studied this year.

In *IPC*, the children will be looking at the traditional clothing of their home country. They will be exploring fabrics and colors used to create these clothing.

- Please remember to check your child's Communication Book daily.
- Home Learning needs to be completed and returned back to the class teacher by Wednesday (1N/1A) or Thursday (1I/1S).
