

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for <u>next</u> week.

In *Literacy*, we will be continuing to look reports and journalistic writing. We will focus on the use of modal verbs, semi-colons and reported speech to improve our interview skills and report writing.

In *Numeracy*, we will be identifying regular polygons by identifying the size of their interior angles. We will be revising metric units of weight, capacity and length. Also, we will be placing fractions on a number line and looking at mixed numbers and improper fractions.

In *Science*, we will be investigating how seeds need water and warmth for germination, but not light, and making predictions based on scientific knowledge. We will be creating a line graph to present our results and interpreting our data thinking about whether it is sufficient to draw conclusions.

In IPC, we will be recreating the Bayeux Tapestry using cloth, pastels and coffee stains. The students will be working in small groups and focussing on the personal learning goal of co-operation.

In ICT, students will using Scratch to draw basic and complex shapes and learning how to tessellate them. Students will be encouraged to add colour, words and movement to their tessellations.

In PSHE, we will be understanding why the children are motivated to making a positive contribution to supporting others. The children will continue with their preparations for the planned Fair on Wednesday 14 March.

For *Spellings*, students will receive their spelling lists every week and will be tested on the list on the same day, the following week. Please see student's timetables to see when they have spellings. Students will have 11 words to learn during the course of the week.
