Starters: - Numeracy

 Draw a picture or poster to show halves and quarters.

 Draw a picture or poster to show halves and quarters, thirds and fifths.

 Draw a picture or poster to show equivalent fractions of your choice.

Main Course – you **MUST** do these every week:

- Reading – 15-20 minutes at least 3 times per week.
- Spellings – 10 spellings in your spelling books to be tested on a Tuesday.
- Times Tables – your own times tables written in your communication book – tested on a Tuesday also.
- Mathematics
