

Year 1 Home Learning Menu



Starters: Science



Go on a sound walk around your community. Write down or draw pictures to show what you heard.



Using different house hold materials create an instrument that will make a sound.



Using the instrument, you made create a loud and quiet noise. Record what you are doing differently to make the different sounds.



You are going to create an experiment. With a friend or adult, ask them to play your instrument at the same noise level. You will stand close to the instrument and then slowly move away. Record what happens to the noise when you move further away.

Main Course
