The festival gets its name from the row (avali) of clay lamps (deepa) that are lit outside homes to symbolize the inner light that protects from spiritual darkness. This important festival is celebrated by many people around the world and this week some of our classes also enjoyed celebrating Diwali with their own deepa.

As an international school we are privileged to have a school community with more than 35 nationalities. This is a rich environment where, through our taught curriculum and also the 'hidden curriculum' that occurs naturally when children are surrounded by people from different countries and diverse
