Messages

Children will review and extend their understanding of equivalent fractions, moving on to recognising common decimal fractions. They will work out unit and non-unit fractions of a quantity and will begin to manipulate fractional and decimal parts of a whole with greater fluency. They will be expected to start to solve problems with fractional notation and be able to explain their thinking using correct terminology.

Themed Learning

Active Planet

We will begin a two week unit focussing on Art skills. Drawing their influence from the Japanese artist Hokusai, the children will be experimenting with a range of printing techniques such as press print and creating a printing block from Lino. The end product will be a two layered print of an exploding volcano.

The children will be setting goals for the new term.

Year 3 / 4 Spanish – Ms Leigh

This week we have continued with our learning of new vocabulary relating to introducing members of the family. We have practised introducing immediate family and sharing important information about them such as name, age etc. later in the week, we tried putting our spoken Spanish into carefully structured sentences. We will continue with this topic in the next coming week.

Year 3 / 4 Spanish – Ms Sutton

Children have been continuing learning about transport, creating dialogues at the train station and stating how they like to travel. The past tense fui (I went) has been introduced. Homework is Linguascope, beginner level, section on transport. Children to practise vocabulary through activities.

Year 4 French - Miss Wood

This week we have continued working on vocabulary connected to the topic of French towns and cities. We have learnt names of new buildings and explored French towns, using computers. Children have practised prepositions of place and have reviewed directional vocabulary, asking where to find places and where people are going. Homework: To complete the sheet on places and prepositions.

Year 3 / 4 French – Mrs Rae

This week we have been learning how to pronounce the French alphabet and learnt many songs to help us with this. Ask your children to share these with you! We have begun to look at vocabulary to do with our families and home. This week's homework is to draw our own family members and label them in a family tree.
