

IBDP Fast Facts

MAY 2021 EXAMINATION SERIES

- 14th IB cohort to graduate, growing from 6 graduates in 2008 to 96 in 2021
- BIS students awarded 40.4 average points compared to the world average of 33.02
- 6 students awarded the maximum score of 45 points putting them in the top 1.4% of students worldwide
- A further 18 students received a near perfect score of 44 points
- 68% of students awarded 40 points or more, compared to the world average of 9%
- 90% of students achieved 35 or more points. In total, 94% of our IBDP graduates scored above the world average.
- 21.3 % of our students were awarded a Bilingual Diploma
- BIS Diploma pass rate was 100%
- 74% of students achieved Grade A or B for the Extended Essay, compared to the world average of 41%; 79% achieved a Grade A or B for Theory of Knowledge compared with the world average of 39%



MAY 2021 EXAMINATION SERIES

- 99.4% of grades awarded were A*-C
- 83.8% of grades achieved were A*/A
- 60 students, 48% of the year group, achieved A*/A in all subjects
- 77 students, 63% of the year group, achieved A*/A in at least 8 subjects
- 38 students were entered in to their IGCSE Extended Mathematics one year early and whilst in Year 10 (Grade 9) all received A*

IBDP students study 6 subjects, 3 at Higher Level (HL) and 3 at Standard Level (SL). Final results in each subject are awarded according to the 7-point grading scale as stated by the International Baccalaureate Organisation (IBO), in which 1 is the lowest and 7 is the highest.

A maximum of 3 bonus points is awarded for successful completion of the DP core subjects of Theory of Knowledge (ToK) and Extended Essay (EE), each of which is graded from A – E. This makes a total of 45 points.


Full participation in, and completion of, the Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) core element is also required.

As a school we do not rank our students, calculate GPAs or convert IB points to other scales.
