### Learning Theme

Our chosen author is the award winning author Emily Gravett. Last week we introduced two of her books: Dogs and Orange Pear Apple Bear. The children really loved playing with the toy dogs in the classroom, making houses for them, feeding them and looking after them.

We had a look at ooranges, apples and peras. A big thank you to all of you who sent fruit in for our chopping session. The children used their senses to explore the fruit, they touched, squeezed, smelled and tasted. We printed with fruit and made observtional drawings.

Next week we will read two more of Emily Gravett's stories: Monkey and Me and The Blue Chameleon.

Monkey and Me is a delightfully story with lots of repetitive phrases, about a little girl's visit to the zoo. Accompanied by her favourite monkey toy, they imitate the actions of the animals they see.

The second book we will be exploring is the Blue Chameleon. The Chameleon hopes to find a friend so changes his shape and colour in order to fit in. When he looks and acts like himself he finds a friend who is just like him.

## Physical development

## Expressive arts and design

We will experiment with mixing paints to make new colours, observing carefully and talking about what we see.

Vocabulary: green, red, blue, purple, pink, green, yellow, orange, brown, black, white.
