Starters: Reading

Write down the purpose of the following non-fiction features: contents page, index, glossary, heading, sub-heading, picture and caption.



In your reading book, identify any words you do not know and guess what their meaning is. Use a dictionary to check.



From your book, look at some adjectives. Why did the author choose to use these words?
