

At-a-glance Tanzania guide 2018

Please ensure you take the time to read the necessary information regarding our Trip to Tanzania that is on our school internet pages. However below are some essential items not to miss!

V	Check packing lists online. Important items are sun-cream, wide brimmed hat, goggles, gardening gloves, 2 x litre water bottles for drinking, closed toe shoes for project work, bug spray. *Note: electronics are not covered under the insurance policy. Do not bring a laptop/ipad or video games. You will have access to your phone for 1 hour each evening to call home; you will need a separate camera
	Pay by Event link (on school website) the Charitable donation (2,400 RMB or US\$350) before 12 th November 2018 Pay by Event link (on school website) the Insurance premium (446 RMB or US\$65) before 12 th November 2018
	Ensure all China visas for return to China are up-to-date.
	Requirement of 3 x 2inch passport photos for documentation (1 x yellow fever, 2 x Tanzania Visa)
	<u>Visa Application</u> : By Wednesday 10th October handed to Form Tutor: Passport and completed Tanzanian Visa Application form / Parent permission forms (these forms available on the Website & Managebac) plus <u>415RMB Visa Fee (Cash)</u>
	<u>Yellow Fever Vaccination</u> : If organised by the school, hand in passport photos and <u>281RMB fee</u> (<u>Cash</u>) to Form Tutor by Wednesday 10 th October If organised independently, hand in yellow fever document to Form Tutor by Wednesday 10 th October
	Ensure all NAE documentation completed on line with JotForm (email sent 14 th September with link) as soon as possible – any difficulties please let me know.
	REMEMBER please ensure you have taken advice on Malaria from your own GP. As a school our only stipulation is we do not recommend Larium/Mifloquine – any decision is at your own discretion.
