## SCHOOL PRINCIPAL

As we come to the end of the 2020-21 academic year, I can look back with real pride when I see the way our school has met the challenges of the COVID pandemic. It sounds strange to say this, but I genuinely believe that considering the challenges we faced, it has been our most successful year ever.



With so many schools around the world facing significant periods of closure, to be able to provide over 1,200 BSG students with a year of continuous face-to-face learning has to be worth celebrating.

Probably the most difficult challenge was to get all our teachers back into Guangzhou, and even as I write this, we still have 3 teachers who are awaiting documentation to allow them to return to China. I am sure that you will join me in thanking Lorna Hwang, Gemma Campbell and Jason Yu for their patience and their willingness to continue to support any of our students who are also stranded overseas. This is a challenge that international schools may face again next year, particularly with regards to any newly-appointed teachers, but as a school, we have taken a number of steps to ensure that whatever happens, we will continue to provide our students with face-to-face learning opportunities.

China's success in controlling this virus has been largely down to their ability to impose strong restrictions very quickly, and their determination to keep restrictions in place for as long as necessary. Their success has allowed us to safely operate our school, and I am grateful for the support of the various government agencies in making this happen. The removal of restrictions has felt frustratingly slow at times, with ASAs, sports competitions, events and trips still impacted. However, we have much to be grateful for, and little by little, the broad and vibrant curriculum that has helped BSG gain such an impressive reputation within Guangzhou is being re-introduced.

It was a pleasure to be able to invite parents to see our end of year performance of 'We will Rock You', so hopefully 2021-22 will be the year that we reintroduce everything that made BSG successful, including our International Day celebration.

As we approach the holidays, I would like you to join me in thanking all of our staff who have again shown their impressive commitment to our school by foregoing any overseas travel during the summer. For many teachers, they have not been able to physically get together with close relatives for over 18 months. This is not easy, and we can only imagine how emotional they will feel when they can travel freely, without quarantines. Perhaps 2021-22 will be the year that this becomes a reality.

There is no doubt that the biggest frustration of my year was the extended delay to the opening of our Olympic Park Campus. Due to the extended delay, we expect opening numbers to be much smaller than originally planned, but are confident that once we are open, this will become the most popular Primary School within Guangzhou.

I can think of no more exciting challenge than being able to lead the development of this wonderful new campus, and in our first year, I will be on site every day. We have lots of exciting plans for the campus, and I am looking forward to meeting our founding families, who will be making history when they arrive on the first day of the term. With state-of-the-art facilities, excellent teachers and small class sizes, I am confident that Olympic Park's inaugural students will all make great progress.

As I reach the end of my message, it is wonderful to be able to report that our A-Level graduates have received over 100 offers, and we are excited to report that we once again have students attending some of the world's top universities, including King's College London, University of Edinburgh and Hong Kong University to name but a few.

Enjoy the break and we will see everyone again on Monday 23rd August, when the new academic year begins.

So, how have we managed to ensure our children’s learning has not been compromised by the pandemic? What are the ingredients for this success story? No doubt, the support we have had from the local and national authorities has been excellent, and ensured we have both the information and resources we needed as a school. However, it is the determination of Team BSG that has pulled together and displayed an incredible level of ambition to get us to where we are today.

First and foremost, our incredible teachers and teaching assistants, who show such a high level of commitment to their students that is difficult to put it in to words. Of course, successful teaching and learning requires students who are respectful, responsible and resilient. We have always been very proud of our children, but to see them manage the changes brought about by the pandemic has been hugely humbling. No challenge has been too big, and their ability to adapt to new routines and processes without complaint is the best possible advert for BSG. Lessons have continued, exams have gone ahead, Global Campus competitions have been won, Community Programmes have never ceased and the School Production was amazing! Even as tiredness has set in, their determination and purpose has not waned — as one parent commented: “My child wants to go to school on the weekends, too!”
