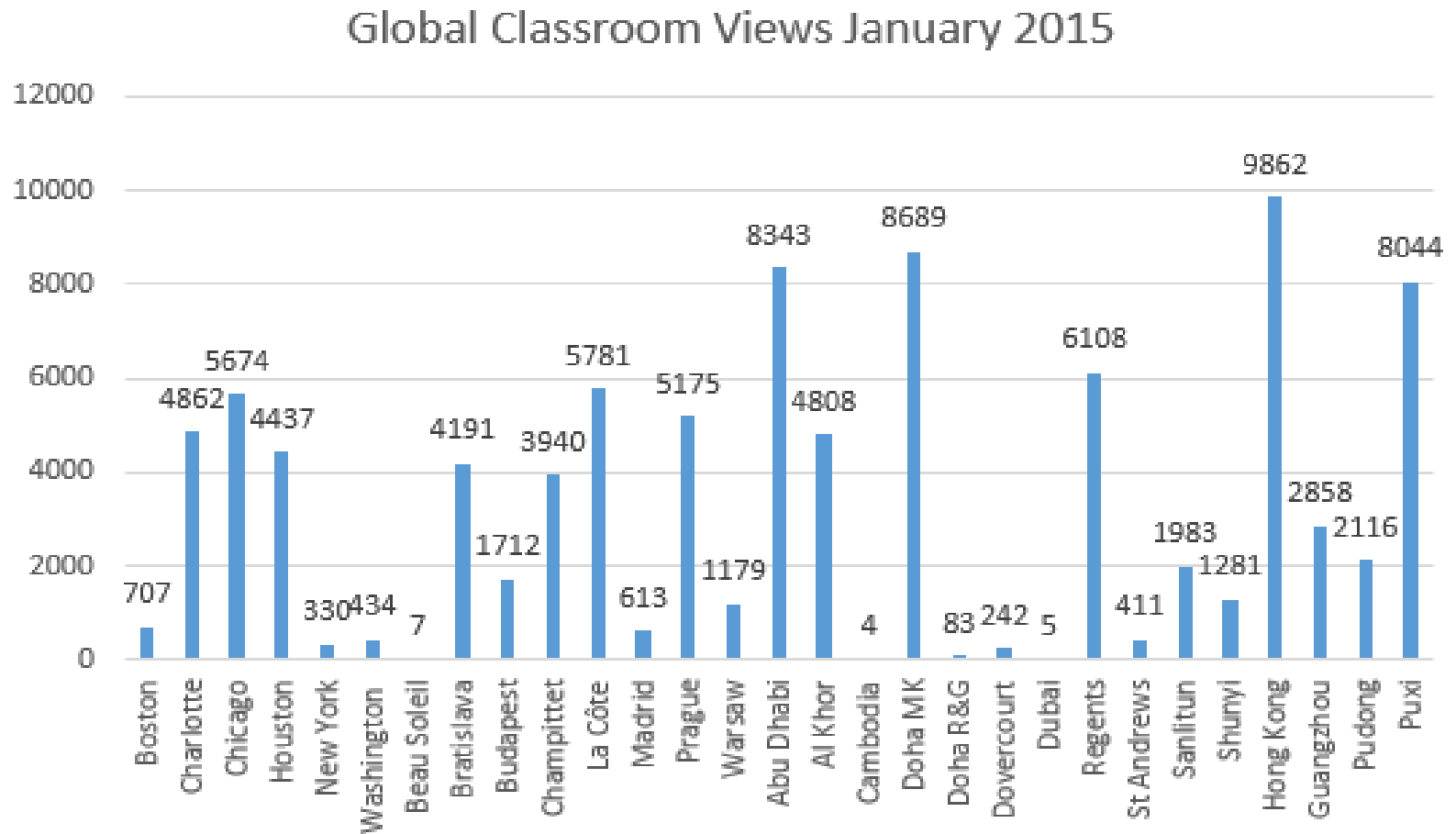

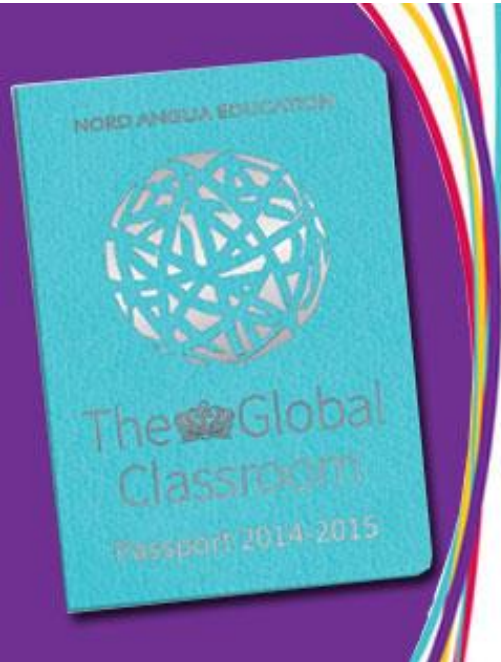

Illustration competition 2015

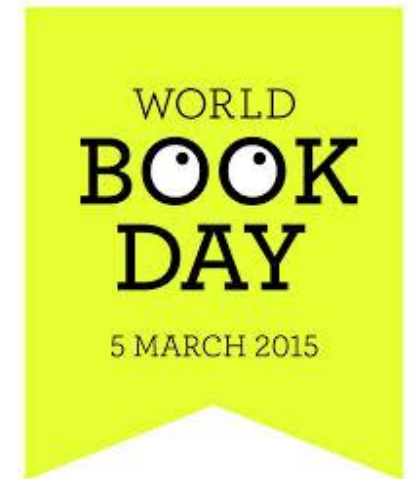
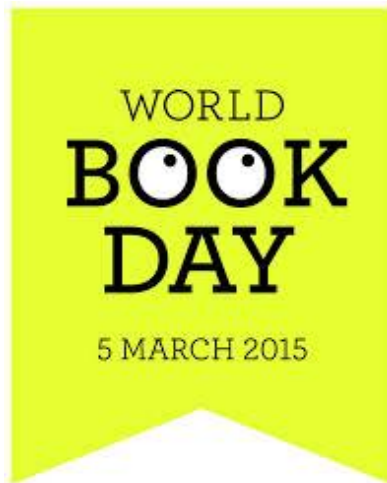
