## Our subject in the Spotlight this week is... VISUAL ARTS

Year 7: This term students have begun an illustration project where they are reading short stories written by Tim Burton and using their imagination to create the characters from the description. The students will then turn these illustrations into shadow puppet performances.

Year 8: Year 8 have been learning how to use the rule of thirds to compose photographs and put these skills into action by taking photography portraits of their partners. They will then be using these photographs to create a painted 'self portrait'!

Year 9: After the excitement of developing a conceptual final piece based on the idea of 'infection', Year 9 students are now developing their more traditional skills and have started a project based on 'Still life'. This will involve them creating drawings, paintings and prints using their 'formal element' skills.

Year 10: Year 10 this term have enjoyed a trip to Gilman Barracks to visit the 'Oceanic' exhibition in order to inspire them for their new piece of coursework which will be called 'The Ocean'. Students will be working independently to create a body of work which meets the assessment objectives and will complete their final piece in exam conditions as a 'mock exam'.

Year 11: Year 11 received their exam paper on February the 1st and have been working hard to create the preparatory work for their exam. Their theme this year is 'Collections' and will culminate in a 10 hour exam in April.
