Year 3 will be going on an exciting educational visit around the sights of Shanghai. Each Class will be visiting a different area of Shanghai to build up a geographical profile of this city. The locations will include the Bund (3X and 3S), People's Square (3P and 3I) and Yu Yuan Gardens (3U and 3B). This visit is connected with our Themed Learning focus Paintings, Pictures and Photographs, and will be a great opportunity for children to further develop their knowledge of the world around them.

This visit will take place on Tuesday 20 October.

We will be leaving school at approximately 8.50am and returning to school in the afternoon in time for the usual end of day arrangements. We will travel by private school bus and ensure that children are wearing seat belts.
