This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next week**.

In **Literacy**, we will be continuing our 'Big Writing Adventure' by further analysing the features of an incident report before planning and writing our own incident report. We will also look at the effect passive and active voice has on a piece of writing.

In **Numeracy**, we will be solving calculations using simple formulae and solving problems involving scale, proportion and ratio.

In **Science**, we are participating in a debate about the impacts of deforestation and looking at the causes of acid rain.

In **IPC**, the children will be investigating the impact of using fossil fuels has on the environment and choosing ways to present their findings.

In **ICT**, we will be continuing with our 'Lego Challenge' by uploading photos of our creations onto the Global Campus Website before explaining and evaluating our designs.
