

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next week**.

In **Numeracy**, the children will be revising some of the key learning objectives that they have covered this year. We will be looking at any gaps in their learning to give them some extra support or opportunities to extend their learning. We will cover number bonds, addition, subtraction and time.

In **Literacy**, the children will be revising the common exception words and revisiting all the sounds in preparation for assessment week. They will also be practising real and nonsense words for the Phonics Screening test.

In **Science**, the children are going to begin revising for their upcoming assessments. The children are going to be completing activities that cover the topics we have studied this year. They will look over Ourselves, Being Alive, Hearing Sounds, Growing Plants, Pushes and Pulls and What is it made of?

In **IPC**, the children will be looking at the new topic, 'All Dressed Up'. They will look at the traditional dress of Qatar and compare and discuss their own traditional dress from their home country.
