

Chinese Second Language Curriculum Overview Key Stage 3- Year 9

<u>Skills</u>

Students understand the gist and identify main points and detail intexts drawn from a variety of contexts and topic areas on written resources read. They learn to answer a variety of question types on the reading materials. Students paraphrase and manipulate language in order to answer questions appropriately. They recognise points of view, attitudes and emotions and is able to draw conclusions from familiar topics containing unfamiliar words. They learn to understand unfamiliar language and to extract meaning from more complex language.

Communities

Students learn to introduce what shops and public places are there nearby home. They learn to express likes and dislikes of different shops using simple explanations that show an understanding of adjectives, providing reasons. They ask and respond to questions about communities.

Asking the Way

Students learn to describe how and how long to get to a specific destination in speaking and writing with directions. They introduce a Nanjing map with phrases and sentences learnt.

Travel and Transport

Students learn to describe the time and types of transport to arrive destinations for purpose. They ask and respond to questions about transportation. They make a travel plan with phrases and sentences learnt.

Holidays

Students learn to introduce their holidays and tell the schedules. They make a holiday plan with phrases and sentences learnt in speaking and writing.

Weather and Seasons

Students learn to identify different seasons. They learn to express likes and dislikes of weather conditions and seasons, providing reasons. They ask and respond to questions about weather and seasons. They compare different season.

Famous Sites and Cities

Students learn to express likes and dislikes of famous sites and famous cities, providing reasons. They introduce details and interesting information of famous sites and famous cities.
