Learning Theme of the week



The Chinese New Year celebrations are fast approaching and over the coming weeks we will find out more about this event. We will talk to the children about the Chinese zodiac and introduce the animals associated with the years. 2014 is the year of the horse and we will focus on that in our art activities.

Literacy

We will write our wishes on special cards and we will hang them in the wishing tree outside the classroom. We will use special magic pens to write our wishes. We will try to ascribe meaning to marks.

Vocabulary: wish, want, hope, happy, healthy

Role-play

We will set up a Chinese restaurant. The children will be making menus and writing down orders.

Vocabulary: rice, noodles, chicken, vegetables, juice, milk

Art

We will explore Chinese art with calligraphy, cherry blossom paintings and blue and white pottery. We will be making items associated with Chinese New Year like lanterns.

Vocabulary: paint, cherry blossom, vase, lanttern

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As you become more familiar with tapestry, you will find at the bottom of each observation the development matters statements. We use these on a daily basis and many activities cover several areas of learning. Below are some of the statements we will be focusing on through child initiated learning and our teacher inputs.
