## Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next week**.

In *Numeracy*, the children will be completing a variety of carousel activities. At each station they will be completing a different activity based on their previous learning. Mostly the children will focus on addition, subtraction, fractions, time, 2D and 3D shapes and word problems.

In Literacy, the children will be completing a variety of different independent activities including phonics, sentence building, letter formation, writing and reading. The children will also be completing their big write assessment on Thursday where they will be using all the skills they have learned throughout Year 1.

In *Science*, the children will be completing varies carousel activities. They will be using their knowledge of plants and how they grow to complete hands on theme related tasks, such as leaf rubbing and gluing, and soil play centers.

In *PSHE*, the children will continue to look at how to celebrate successes and the feeling and emotions that may feel when they achieve a long term goal.

In *IPC*, the children will be completing a variety of carousel activities. At each station they will be completing a different activity based on their previous learning of the topic of 'Our World'.

In *Art*, the children will continue with the theme mosaics. The children will be looking at the different shapes of tiles and putting them together to create a mosaic of their own.
