Mathematics

#### Number and place value

- · Students will know and understand place value up to 1,000,000.
- Compare and order numbers and round numbers to the nearest 10,100,1,000 and 10,000.
- Deepen their understanding of Roman numerals and explore negative numbers.

### Addition and subtraction

- · Students will develop their use of the formal written method for addition and subtraction.
- Add and subtract numbers with up to 5 digits and confidently handle multiple exchanges.
- · Students will consistently use the inverse operations to self-check their learning.

#### **Multiplication & division**

- Students will explore prime, square and cube numbers.
- Understand what happens when multiplying and dividing numbers by 10,100,1000.
- Use and apply this knowledge to answer a range of problem-solving questions.
