




Entrepreneurial Studies Program

In partnership with Start Up Studio, Windermere Preparatory School offers an Entrepreneurial Studies Program that teaches business and entrepreneurship skills over the course of three years. The program aims to diversify traditional classroom education through experiential learning, enabling students to identify their strengths and discover the entrepreneur within. Our students dive into a hands-on curriculum

that emphasizes "learning by doing" and constant collaboration. They are mentored by practicing entrepreneurs and solve problems for real businesses. In the program, students learn that failure is not a negative outcome, but a positive movement toward new breakthroughs.

STEAM Education and MIT Collaboration

In a groundbreaking collaboration with the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), Windermere Preparatory School has designed a series of in-school challenges at the intersection of several STEAM disciplines, including bioengineering, robotics, and computer science. Every year, our teachers and students participate in workshops with MIT academics, giving them an opportunity to learn directly from the world's leading STEAM institution.





Computer Science Program

In today's tech-driven world, computer science skills are essential for success. Windermere Preparatory School offers a two-course program, including Introduction to Computer Science and International Baccalaureate Computer Science, to prepare students for life as digital natives. Students may include IB Computer Science as a second Science course, in pursuit of a full International Baccalaureate Diploma. Students in this program are exposed to Computer Science Theory, Java Programming, Program Analysis, Data Structures, Operations, Algorithms, and Computational Thinking.



Robotics (New in 2018-2019)

To complement the school's growing Computer Science program, Windermere
Preparatory School has now expanded its scope into
Robotics. Our course, based on the VEX Design System, will expose students to a variety of Robotic concepts including
Object Manipulation, Mechanical Power Transmission, Drivetrain Design, Lifting Mechanisms, and Systems Integration.




Brian Hoff Head Basketball Coach

A supportive residential community with an immersive learning experience, Windermere Preparatory School prides itself on an international boarding program with students from over 15 countries. Boarding students are embraced into a safe and welcoming environment that builds their independence.

Your Home Away from Home

Windermere Preparatory School is pleased to open the doors to the Venetian Isle, a brand new townhome community for boarding students. The townhome complex houses six-student apartments, which each include a living room, bathroom and game room, enabling students to experience comfort and community inside their own home. The surrounding property features common areas and amenities, such as a clubhouse and pool,

designed to encourage interaction between students. The Venetian Isle is conveniently located near campus and boasts several nearby restaurants, a beauty salon, food market and fitness center.

Wholesome Nutrition

We have dedicated chefs and certified nutritionists who ensure that our students are well-nourished at all times. Students receive three healthy and nutritious meals on campus every day. We have also made nutrition a core element of our physical education program, so that students understand how their eating habits impact their education and wellness as a whole.

A Safe Environment

Providing boarding students with a safe and secure experience is our top priority. Staff in-residence supervise the boarding facilities and support the social and emotional well-being of the students.

Professional security systems keep students safe at all times. Students can access an on-site medical clinic, registered nurses, school counselor, and outside physicians to address any health concerns.

Additionally, parents can reach a member of our staff 24 hours a day, seven days a week.


