Dear Parents/Guardians,

Year 5 will be going on an exciting educational visit to the Shanghai Urban Planning Museum. This experience is connected to our Themed Learning topic, 'Building a Village'. It will be a great opportunity for the children to further develop their knowledge of settlements and how these have changed over time. The information they collect will help them to plan their own village models during our classroom activities.

This visit will take place on Tuesday 20 October.

We will be leaving school at approximately 8.50am and returning to school in the afternoon in time for the usual end of day arrangements. We will travel by private school bus and ensure that children are wearing seat belts.

Students who normally have school lunch will be provided with a packed lunch on the day. All other students will need to provide their own lunch. You may pack an additional drink and small healthy (nut-free) snack should you wish to.

Students will be required to wear uniform as normal on the day, but should wear comfortable walking shoes and a jacket.

We would like two parent volunteers from each class to support us on this day. Please let your child's class teacher know if you would like to volunteer.
