YEAR 7

YOUNG LEADERS AWARD

What is this?

All of Year 7 will complete a Young Leaders Award which will give you knowledge of how to organise and lead small games and activities within PE lessons or ECAs.



When will this be delivered?

The guided learning hours are between 6-10 for this course.

Parts of the course will be delivered during PE lessons and you will have the opportunity to lead small groups of peers in different activities.

You will also complete written work at home.

How will this be assessed?

Learners will receive a Leadership Journal which they can use to record what they have done in sessions, what they have learnt, what they have enjoyed and what they have found the most challenging.

Certificates will be awarded once learners have completed the course and lead short sessions with peers.

Volunteering opportunities...

- All Year 7 pupils have been allocated a class in the lower Primary school and they are expected to assist with a variety of activities between 7:30-8am each day.
- This will allow pupils to develop leadership skills and also build strong relationships between the year groups at NAIS.



YEAR 8

SPORTS LEADERS

What is this?

All of Year 8 will complete a Sports Leaders Award Level 1 which will develop must deliver a **one** hour session in an activity.



When will this be delivered?

The guided learning hours are 33 hours for this course.

Parts of the course will be delivered during PE lessons and you will have the opportunity to lead within lessons to peers.

Elements of the course will be delivered and pupils can practice skills before the final assessment.

You will also complete written work within PSE lessons with Mr Cross and Mr Doherty.

How will this be assessed?

Learners must complete a variety of worksheets which they can use to record different elements of the course, for example what information will be needed to plan a sporting activity.

Tutors/teachers will also assess pupils through observations, questions and also videos.

Certificates will be awarded once learners have completed the course and lead a **one** hour session with peers.

Volunteering opportunities...

- During our Global Asia Games, pupils who are not competing in events will have a role during the Athletics day.
- This will allow them to display the leadership skills they have developed as we host this fantastic event for a number of International Schools in Asia.

MONITORING PROGRESS AT NAIS...

- We will be introducing a Leadership page within Firefly which parents can keep up to date with.
- This will include videos and photos of pupils progress in either the Young Leaders or Sports Leaders Level 1 courses.

PROGRESSIONS FOR PUPILS...

- Once pupils have completed the Sports Leadership Level 1 qualification, they will be able to complete the Sports Leadership Level 2 course.
- This will allow pupils to gain more qualifications and also expand their knowledge.

Higher Sports Leadership

In the future we are hoping to offer Higher Sports Leadership to pupils 16+.

This course is a Level 3 amounts to 30 points on the University points system in the United Kingdom.
