Curriculum Brief 19/20 Term 2

Curriculum Synopsis

The curriculum of Islamic Studies for year six focus on verses of the Qur'an, and the messages of the Prophet Muhammad (Hadith). It aims to give pupils a clear, thorough understanding of Islamic teachings, moral behavior and Islamic etiquette. Furthermore, it aims to give pupils a clear, thorough understanding of Islamic teachings, moral behavior and Islamic etiquette, and its contribution to modern science.

Some of the influential personalities in Islamic history are studied, such as the life of Prophet Muhammad (PBUH), role models, values and ethics. Moreover, student's skills in Tajweed are developed through reading the Holy Qur'an.

The Islamic syllabus covers five main areas which are imparted to students in a continuous and a systematic way to support their understanding, enhance their reflective thinking.

For the second term the students will study the following topics:

- Surat AL-Mulk 1-5
 Students will start understanding how to do tafseer for the verses and link it with our daily life.
- The Rules of Silent Noon and Tanween (Iqlab, Idhhaar, Ikhfaa' and Idghaam)
- Few Signs of the Hour.
- Students will learn about the signs of the coming of the Hour and deduce the role of Islam in resisting despair and frustration.
- The Believer between Gratitude and Patience. Students will Recognize the overall meaning of the Hadith
- The Greater Battle of Bader Students will learn the historical events, be aware of the dangers of wars between nations and the importance to trust the leaders.
- Imam Malik.
 Students will explain the status of Imam Malik in Islamic culture.

Supporting at Home

The support at home aims to document the student's relationship with the Holy Quran as the first source of knowledge, behavior, values, taste and beauty in order to build a Quranic mentality and psychology, by continuing to read the Qur'an and considering the provisions of intonation (*tajweed*).

One of the key elements of this support is to implant the love of Prophet Muhammad "peace be upon him" in the heart of the student through the experience of the Prophet's biography, and to highlight the life of the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) as a good example and a role-model to follow.
