

Literacy

This week we will continue to look at myths. We will study different types of myths and their features. We will be starting to write our own myths, based on what we have learnt about the features of different myths. To do this, we will be studying Egyptian myths and by the end of the week the children will have learnt to write their own Egyptian myth.

Phonics

This week in phonics the children will be studying the following sounds or phases:

Stingrays: recapping phase three words and sounds

Starfish: o-e and u-e **Jellyfish:** s, ch, th review

Octopus: alternative spellings for ar and ur

Sharks: alternative ure and o

Pufferfish: using the suffix 'ness' and how the meaning of words change

Maths

This week we will continue to study division and multiplication. We will look at how to apply our knowledge of multiplication and division through solving word problems, using grouping,

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sharing and arrays to support our problem solving skills. We will also look at how multiplication and division are the inverse of each other and how this can support our problem solving.

Themed Learning - The Stories People Tell

Over the course of this topic we will share legends and myths from around the world with the children. The children will look at the origin of the story and compare legends from different countries. The children will use their skills in Digital Literacy to research a story and then present it in a PowerPoint. Art activities will focus on 3D skills and textiles as we look at art as a means of telling stories through different mediums, e.g. masks, plates, Greek pots and dream catchers.

In unison with this topic, we will look at sound waves in Science and coding skills in Computer Science.

Vocabulary

Literacy – myth, legend, speech marks, speech bubble, hero, villain, stories, texts, hot seating. **Maths** – multiple, times, repeated addition, division, repeated subtraction, inverse, sharing, grouping.

Humanities – myth, legend, story, hero, research, textiles, sound waves, coding. **Computing Science-** keyboard, input, code, app, instruction, log on, log off, control, enter
