## Starters: Times Tables



Complete the times table homework assigned on Mathematics. There are 2 activities to complete.



Complete the Year 3 times table challenge (see attached sheet)



Write each of your times table number sentences on individual cards and the answers on separate cards. Turn all the cards face down and mix them up. Lay out your cards in rows and flip over two cards at a time. Read each card aloud to see if they match. Keep them if they match or flip them over and try again if not!

**Main Course** – you **MUST** do these every week:

- Reading- 3 times per week
- Spellings- see blue spelling book
- Times Tables
- Mathematics
- Reading Eggs

- Everyone **must** finish the main course every week. Work must be completed by Tuesday.
- Dessert projects are optional. If you have completed it, you will be asked to present your work to your teachers and peers.
- If you are feeling *extra* hungry, you can order from the starters. Each dish has a difficulty rating. The more chilies, the more *challenging* the task!
