#### Literacy

After a very successful week of detective work and solving the 'Mystery in the Kitchen', we will be continuing our narrative work on mystery texts. Students will be putting their detective skills to the test when they are required to piece together a variety of clues to determine who the bag of 'mystery items' belongs to. They will need to be able to articulate their ideas and justify their thought process when presenting their theories to the class. The week will conclude students writing their own mystery story. Our SPAG learning this week is singular and plural nouns, the 'ed' suffix and rules to apply it (change y to i and add ed) and the correct use of commas.

## Maths

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Next week in Maths children will be moving on from studying Area to look at Volume. They will complete a variety of investigations which will broaden their knowledge of this topic, and use practical materials to deepen their understanding. In mental maths we will look at strategies to multiply large numbers, by applying our existing knowledge of multiplication facts.

## Themed Learning

## 'Water for everyone'

Our Themed Learning topic in Term 2 is "Water for everyone", investigating the big question "Is water the most valuable resource on the planet?"

Themed Learning this week will involve the children learning about 'microbes' and their role in an ever changing planet. We will discover the positive and negative effects of microbes and discuss their proliferation in 'water'. In PSHCE we will discuss how different countries are affected by their supply of clean water and how scientific developments can assist in increasing the accessibility of fresh water to society. We will end the week by building a filtration system to cleanse dirty water.

In Art, children have been learning about various watercolour techniques and experimenting with ways of creating different effects. We have also looked at impressionist and abstract artists such as Monet, Turner, Rothko and Pollock. They are now applying what they have learned to create a watercolour landscape painting in an impressionist style, focusing on colour and space in their painting to give an overall feel or mood.
