Welcome to the Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs) programme at the EYI Campus, BIS HCMC. The extensive programme on the EYI Campus is designed to extend existing learning opportunities beyond the classroom and to give all children a wider range of fun experiences that enhance the core curriculum. This booklet will help your child to choose their activities for Term 3 CCAs for the 2021-2022 academic year.

There is an extensive range of CCAs available to choose from each week at the BIS EYI Campus, and we would like to challenge and encourage students to explore some of the exciting new activities being introduced. For a full list of CCAs offered for Term 3, please see below.

As part of our continued enrichment programme, we have organised clubs into 5 categories to help all children choose a variety of clubs with the aim to vary their experiences. The categories are:

Art, Community, Language, Sports, and Technology

Clubs are divided into 2 different types:

Free Clubs – offered by teachers covering a wide range of different activities on a set day and time. *Paid clubs* – offered by outside providers, these clubs often require specialist tuition.

One of these CCAs is a Swimming Squad Club that will be offered by the PE Department. Keep in mind that this selection will count as your one free club.

Each child in F2 to F3 is offered <u>one Free Club</u>. Each child in Y1 to Y2 is offered <u>one Free Club and</u> <u>unlimited Paid Clubs</u>. Please note that <u>we do not guarantee that the free club will be approved</u> as all selections are generated randomly by the computer.

Kegistering your child:

How do you register your child for a club?

As a school, BIS HCMC have moved away from the previous host, CHQ, to a brand new, user friendly provider, SchoolsBuddy. This move between platforms will provide you as parents a much smoother experience. Details on how to access SchoolsBuddy will be provided later in this booklet.

You may register your child for a club from <u>Monday 28th of March at 5.00pm until Wednesday 30th</u> <u>March at 5.00pm.</u> Clubs have maximum and minimum numbers which change according to the activity. See instructions on the following pages for Schools Buddy Sign-up.



For those popular clubs that have set student limits, spaces are chosen randomly by SchoolsBuddy and those who gain a place are notified. Children who sign up for paid clubs that are oversubscribed will be placed on a waiting list. Clubs may be cancelled if there are not enough children as required.

Paid clubs will be confirmed via email to those who have been allocated a place. Please note that if a paid CCA fails to reach minimum numbers, the club will not run.

On-line Activity Selection

All activities (free and paid) need to be selected on-line. Please see following pages for instructions and you will be able to see updates and changes to your approved activities through your on-line SchoolsBuddy homepage.

<u>Choosing carefully is vital as the system will not be able to make changes once CCAs have been</u> <u>allocated</u>. We are hopeful that further decrees will be announced that will allow us to run our Co-Curricular Activities (CCA) programme in Term 3.


