All venues are ones that are currently used by the school regularly for their after school programmes and inter school sports competitions.

There will be toilet facilities and drinking water available at all the sites.

First aid will be provided by St. John's Ambulance on site during each competition.

Medical insurance – this will work the same as residential trips. There will be a form to complete prior to the trip with the children's medical insurance details.



Meals & Refreshments

- Breakfast and Dinner will be provided at the hotel. Packed lunches (Subway) will also be provided at the venues on each day. Mid-morning and mid-afternoon snack will be provided at the venues. There will be water stations available at all the different venues.
- All meals and snacks are included in the Games Package.
- All dietary requirements will be catered for.



Transport

- Airport transfers and transport to and from the hotel to the games venues will be arranged by the host school and are included in the tournament fee.
- All buses will have seatbelts.
- For the day trip on the Wednesday prior to the games, SCIPS will help advise in contacts for reputable tour companies and bus operators.

Supporters Accommodation

 Accommodation is limited at the participant's hotel therefore parents wishing to attend will need to book at one of the recommended hotels.

 A parent's supporter liaison representative from St. Christopher's will forward details about suitable hotels at which parents can stay.

Visas

Some nationalities may need a visa to enter Malaysia. This will be dealt with once the team has been selected.

All travellers will need to ensure their passport is valid for <u>6 months</u> after the departure date.

Passport must not expire before **November 15th 2016.**



Communication

- Telephone we will have a local sim card given to us on arrival at the host school. This number will be emailed either prior to departure (if available) or on the day of arrival.
- We will also provide contact numbers of personnel at the host school.
- There will be a daily blog which can be accessed from home. This will include an update of each day.
- Children will not be permitted to bring phones on the trip.
