The Northern Hills

- The group will be going to the Northern Hills, Hebei Province, north of Beijing.
- Hebei is a province with extraordinary mountain scenery, the Jinshanling section of the Great Wall and fascinating mountain villages where people have maintained a traditional way of life for centuries.



Daily Routine

MORNING

- Wake-up call at approximately 7:30.
- Dressed with clean clothes, brushed hair and down to breakfast by 8:00.
- Room inspections during and after breakfast by members of staff (competition)

EVENING

- Quiet time
- Dinner
- Evening activities
- Showered, teeth brushed, clothes laid out for following day and in bed by 20:00.
- Reading and quiet time
 - Lights off by 20:30 staff patrol until all children are asleep.



Rules

- Do not open your door EVER without knowing who it is. We will have a code. When someone knocks on your door, say "1, 2" Your teacher must reply 'Buckle your shoe" before you open the door. If you do not hear the code, do not open the door.
- If you wake up early, stay in bed until a BSB adult comes to your room. You can read quietly and go to the toilet.
- Stay in your own room; do not go into your friends' rooms. We need to know where to find you at all times. You will have plenty of other opportunities to spend time with your friends.
- Stay with your room partners at all times. All leave the room together if you need to go to teacher's room. Otherwise do not leave your room unless accompanied by a teacher.

Emergencies, Health and Safety.

- Students will be covered by medical insurance (AIG Insurance Company) for the duration of the trip. A form will be coming home shortly with details of this insurance.
- First aid trained staff.
- > 24hour access to first aid kits (provided by school).
- Transport available if necessary.

Emergencies, Health and Safety.

A detailed risk assessment has been carried out by The Hutong for the visit to Hebei province. This will be reviewed by the school when two teachers will accompany The Hutong to all of the sites at the beginning of next month. This is to ensure that the health and safety of your child is considered at each stage of the trip.
