Absence

- If children are going to be absent from school for any reason please contact Rachel Li, our Primary school secretary, as early as possible in the morning, at <u>rachel.li@britishschool.org.cn</u>
- If parents know in advance about a child's upcoming absence from school please inform your child's class teacher plus Rachel Li.
- If we do not receive a reason for a child's absence we will contact parents to determine why the child is not in school. This is a safe guarding measure.
- For extended periods of absence and additional holiday requests, contact Nonie Adams, our Head of Primary at <u>nonie.adams@britishschool.org.cn</u>
- Home learning activities will be provided during long periods of absence.

Early Departure

- If you need to collect your child before 3.30pm, inform our Primary school secretary at <u>rachel.li@britishschool.org.cn</u>
- Prior to leaving school, you must collect a departure form from the Primary Leadership Office or Reception. This will be prepared for you by Ms Rachel.
- You will not be allowed to take your child off school premises without the signed form. Please hand the form to the guards at the front of school.
- Please come to the Primary office to meet your child do not go to their classroom.

Reading at BSB



- This determines their guided reading (instructional) and home reading (independent) level.
- Home reading is an opportunity to practise the skills learnt in class, and also develop their fluency, vocabulary, comprehension and confidence. Children should read at home every day!
- Students participate in daily reading-guided reading, quiet reading, library session, teacher reading, individual reading, shared reading and buddy reading.
