

### **BIS IB Facts - May 2019 Examination Series**

- This is the 12th IB cohort to graduate, growing from 6 graduates in 2008 to 79 in 2019
- Average points awarded to BIS students was 35.8 against the world average of 29.6
- Two of our students were awarded 44 points, placing them in the top 0.44% of IBDP students in the world
- 29.1% of our students are in the top 7.2% with a diploma score of 40 points or higher
- A further 57% achieved 35 points, or higher with 86.1% scoring 30+ points
- 58.2% of our students scored Grade A or B for the Extended Essay, with 87.5% scoring an A or B for Theory of Knowledge
- BIS IB Diploma pass rate: 100% (IB World Average 80%)
