General Uniform Rules

- 1. Primary students should always wear school hats when they are outside to protect them from the sun. DCIS has a 'no hat no play' policy. Students who do not have their school hat will be asked by the duty teacher/class teacher to sit safely in the shade for the duration of the break time.
- 2. Whilst the DCIS backpack is optional it can only be replaced by a dark coloured plain rucksack (navy, black)
- 3. All items of clothing must be marked with appropriate name labels. Every article of clothing, school bag, shoes, snack box, drink bottle, etc. that is brought into school should be labelled.
- 4. Nursery children will need to have a spare set of named uniform in a clearly marked plastic bag to be kept in school in case of accidents.
- 5. In Secondary School, all shirts must be tucked in for male and female students.
- 6. Secondary School male students must have their top button done up and their ties pulled up.
- 7. Students must wear correct footwear at all times plain black leather shoes with black soles. Trainer style shoes, shoes with logos and shoes with non-black soles are not permitted. Please provide an additional pair of sneakers/sandals/trainers to be kept at school for outside play for students in the Primary School. Novelty shoes with flashing lights, squeaking noises or shoes which have the roller ball facility are not allowed.
- 8. Jewellery is not allowed apart from wristwatches and, for girls with pierced ears, a plain gold stud. Ear studs and watches must be removed for P.E. and swimming sessions. If students are required to wear jewellery for religious reasons, please approach the Head of School for permission.
- 9. Long hair must be securely tied back for school.
- 10. Hair should be tidy and of a suitable style for school. Severely short (No. 2 minimum), 'patterned' hair or excessive 'spiking' is not acceptable, neither is the extreme bright/unnatural colouring of hair or any style that draws attention.
- 11. Hair accessories must be of a dark or teal colour and should be small and neat in appearance.
- 12. Long hair (below chin level) should be tied back
- 13. The complete or partial shaving of eyebrows is not allowed.

- 14. Facial hair is not allowed, unless for religious reasons.
- 15. Body piercings, e.g. earrings, nose studs, tongue studs and eyebrow bars are not allowed in school. A small stud earring may be worn.
- 16. A hat must be worn outside. Sunglasses may be worn if a student is medically advised to do so. Sunglasses and hats are not permitted indoors unless a student is medically advised to do so. Sunglasses and hats are not permitted indoors unless under a doctor's orders.
- 17. Students with make-up will be asked to remove it. Coloured nail polish is not permitted.

P.E. Uniform Rules

- Nursery to Year 4 students will all come to school in P.E. kit and will remain in P.E. kit for the day. If a parents
 specifically wants their child to change back into school uniform, they will be allowed to do so but this won't
 be advertised it is only if a parent specifically requests it.
- 2. For swimming, students require Dover Court trunks / swimming costume and / or a Dover Court rash vest. Goggles are optional but highly recommended. Students also need a swimming bag containing a towel and flip / flops to wear to pool side.
- For P.E. lessons, all students are expected to wear the Dover Court P.E. kit. This consists of a dri-fit polo shirt, shorts, adequate sports trainers and white socks. Hats and water bottles are compulsory for P.E. in Primary School and highly recommended in Secondary School.
- 4. Students should also apply sun tan lotion before coming to school on the days they have P.E. lessons.
- 5. For lessons such as football, sufficient safety protection is recommended i.e. football boots and shin pads.
- 6. If Secondary School students wish to play football/basketball/netball at lunchtime, a change of clothing including footwear is required.
- 7. Football boots are not to be worn on campus unless requests by a staff member for a properly supervised game or tournament.

House Day

House details are communicated to all new students in Orientation documents.

Each house has a different colour Dri-Fit house t-shirts that can be purchased at our approved uniform supplier, Lims:

- Ubin dark blue
- Jurong red,
- Newton yellow
- Kanji purple

On house days students need to be dressed in their house t-shirt, PE shorts and trainers.

Non-uniform days guidelines

Throughout the year we have a number of non-uniform days. We ask that the following rules are followed when students are dressing for non-uniform days:

- 1. School shoes, trainers or a shoe with a strap around the ankle should worn. Flip flops, heeled shoes and beach type shoes are not permitted.
- 2. Clothes should cover the body, midriffs should not be shown.
- 3. Shorts/skirts should be no less than 3 inches above the knee.
- 4. See through clothes are not permitted to be worn.
- 5. Makeup, jewelry, unnatural hair colour and nail polish are not permitted, as per the usual uniform standards.
