



Dear parents,

This letter contains important information for Sports Day on Friday 27th November.

Drop off: Pupils should report directly to Kowloon Bay Sports Ground for 8:00am (Please do not come to school). School buses will collect children at the normal times and will drop off at the venue where our teachers will meet them.

Snacks: Water and fruit will be in plentiful supply at the ground and all children have time built in regularly to enjoy these.

Lunch: Years 1 and 2 will be brought back to school and will eat lunch as normal. All other pupils **MUST** bring a packed lunch. No school lunch will be provided.

What to wear: House shirt! Shorts (tracksuit bottoms if cold), comfortable trainers, hat.

Times and events:

- Years 1 & 2 – 9:00am to 11:15am
- Years 3 & 4 – 9:00am to 12:15pm
- Years 5 & 6 – 9:00am to 2:00pm
- Years 7 & 8 – 9:00am to 12:15pm (Sports Leaders) 12:45pm-2:00pm (Competing)

Any parents wishing to collect their children at this time are welcome to do so although please be aware that children remaining with you at the ground are your responsibility and should remain in the spectator stands.

Collection: Buses will take children and teachers back to school at their allotted finish time. All staff and pupils will be back at school by 2:30pm and the usual collection routine will be followed. Pupils who usually take the bus on Friday will be dropped at their regular stop at the usual time.

The school day will finish at 2:45pm for secondary pupils who should then make their way home in the usual fashion.

We understand that parents may have children across the year groups and for convenience may wish to collect them early from Sports Day. We are more than happy to accommodate this but please remember to inform us by emailing the class teacher and bus@nais.hk. If you are staying with your child at the sports ground, please make sure that they are in your care at all times as once their class has left we cannot be responsible for supervision.

Parents: Parents are very welcome to attend the event and should make their way to the stands on arrival. This is a House event so we encourage you to sit with your House and cheer on



the team, dress in house colours and bring banners! If you would like to compete for your House in the parent egg and spoon race, please contact your Head of House to put your name forward!

There is no parking available at the venue, we recommend travelling by MTR. The nearest station is Kowloon Bay.

Weather: Please make sure children are suitably prepared for the weather – sun cream, hoodies, rain jackets as necessary. The current weather forecast is for a cool and dry day. If necessary, children will compete in light rain. In the event of a Thunderstorm Warning or heavy rain, races will be postponed and children will shelter at the sports ground. In the event of an Amber Rainstorm warning before 7:30am, children should report to school and buses will be re-routed. In the very unlikely event of a Red or Black Rain warning or a Typhoon Signal 8, Sports Day will be cancelled and school will be closed.

As this is a whole school event we are expecting all children to attend and will assume consent. Any parents not consenting to Sports Day will need to inform the school in writing and be aware that no other provision will be made for pupils not attending.

We look forward to welcoming as many parents as possible to join us in our first ever Nord Anglia International School, Hong Kong Sports Day.
