


Extracurricular Activities Primary (Years 1–6)

Term 1b 2018-19



Dear Parents.

Extracurricular Activities (ECAs) in Term 1b will start on **Monday 5th November 2018**. The activities will run through until **Thursday 13th December 2018**. As referred to in the ECA email at the beginning of the academic year, students will need to sign up again for this second block of ECAs. Including this extra sign up allows us to provide greater flexibility in the sporting ECAs that we offer so that the students are well-prepared for competitive sport with other schools. I have been in contact with CHQ who are the external service provider for the ECA sign up process and it is possible that the volume of people logging in to sign up for ECAs at the same time will again result in slow processing by the site. Apologies in advance if there is any disruption. Students will have an opportunity to sign up to different ECAs which will run in the second half of this term. Extracurricular activities provide a great opportunity for your child to take part in an activity that falls outside the realm of the normal curriculum. Your child can explore their physical, creative, social or political domains and share diverse interests with like-minded students, perhaps in a different subject area or different key stage.

Students will be asked for multiple preferences although they will be allocated to one, two or three activities only. Not all activities are available to all year groups, please see the descriptions in the brochure. Information on paid activities can also be found within the brochure. The sign up process tries to ensure all students are granted a place on either their first, second or third choice of preference, please see the application guidelines below for detailed instructions.

Application guidelines:

- All activities (free and paid) need to be selected online via CHQ.
- You will be able to register your child for 1 activity during 'sign-up period 1', which will be from Thursday 11th October at 9.00am 2018 until Friday 12th October 2018 at 5.00pm. You will be able to make multiple choices but at this stage you will only be accepted a place on 1 activity only. You will then be able to register your child for another 1 activity if you wish to do so during 'sign up period 2' which will be from Saturday 13th October 2018 at 9.00am until Sunday 14th October 2018 at 5.00pm. Finally, you will be able to register your child for a third activity if you wish to do so during 'sign up period 3' which will be from Monday 15th October 2018 at 9.00am until Tuesday 16th October at 5.00pm.
- After **Tuesday 16th October 2018 at 5.00pm**, students who have signed up for an activity must commit to it for the whole of the first half of the term. Children will not be allowed to swap activities.
- All choices will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.
- If students are absent from their activity without authorisation on more than one occasion they will be removed from the activity and their place will be offered to a student on the waiting list.
- Children wishing to take part in paid activities can make payments by transfer money to school as soon as the child's activity is confirmed. Below are the BIS bank account details:

Please include in the transfer instructions "Name of ECA" and your child's name and class.

- Activities have maximum and minimum numbers, which vary according to the activity.
- Once the maximum number of children has been reached, the activity will be 'closed' and the activity name will be highlighted in red.
- Children who sign up for activities that are oversubscribed will be placed on a waiting list.
- Activities may be cancelled if the total number of participants does not meet the required minimum.

Paid Activities

Paid activities will be confirmed via email to those who have been allocated a place. CHQ has information about each of the activities and all details can be found by expanding the blue information tab. In Term1b, by selecting a paid activity and paying the associate fees, you are agreeing to the school's liability waiver and agree to pay the required fee. Payments need to be made by Friday 26th October 2018, otherwise the place will be offered to the children who have been placed on a waiting list.

You will be able to see updates and changes to your approved activities through your on-line CHQ homepage. Please note your first choices may not always be possible. 
This system has been set up for you to use on a daily basis to select and track all of your child's chosen activities. It can be found by going to the school website (http://www.nordangliaeducation.com/our-schools/vietnam/hanoi/bis) and clicking on the CHQ tab, at the bottom of the homepage. Please follow the instructions below to log on and select your desired activities.

Logging on

Log on using your child's school User name and Password. If your child is in the Primary school, their Password will be their Date of Birth, in the format DDMMYYYY. If your child is in the Secondary school, their password will be 'password' or their own personal password.

How to select your child's activities:

Step 1: Click on My Profile tab.

Step 2: Expand My Activities.

Step 3: Select View/Manage/Submit Activity Choices (2018-2019 Term 1b).

Step 4: For each activity/paid activity add a different number e.g. Monday: Football add 1, Wednesday: Board Games add 2 then 3, 4, 5 etc. to all other clubs you would like to participate in. The **SAVE** button will appear to the right of the activity list, click **SAVE**.

Step 5: Once you're happy with your choices you **MUST** press the **SUBMIT** button at the top of the page. You will receive an automated email confirming your club preferences.

Step 6: To cancel a selection after submitting add a 0 to the desired box then save and submit.

Step 7: If you click onto My Schedule after **Tuesday 16**th **October 2018** you should be able to see your activities by scrolling through to Monday 5th November 2018 (start of Term 1b activities) you will also receive an email of the activities you have been accepted into and students can check display boards within school. Once your selected activities have been approved you will be able to see them by clicking on the on **My Profile** tab to the right of the Home tab on your page.

CHQ Sign-Up Tips for Parents:

Parents please DO NOT place a number 1 in each activity box as this will make your child's favourite activity unclear and as a result your child may miss out on their favourite activity). Please remember to number all choices from 1 (most important activity) to 5, 6 or 7 (or least favourite activity) regardless of the day. Consider & discuss your choices with your child then click the **Submit** button. Clicking the **Submit** button will send your child's activity choices to school. Please remember that you may choose as many activities as you wish that fit into your child's schedule and all activities are subject to a minimum and maximum limit.
