RE: YEAR 8 SHANGHAI HISTORY TRIP, THURSDAY 12 TH MAY 2016

Dear Parent/Guardian

As part of the Year 8 History course, students will be investigating historical change in Shanghai. To do this, we will be organising a trip to the city centre. The History trip will feature a walking tour and visiting various museums in small groups, each accompanied by a teacher and focussing on a different area. After the trip, students will be working on presentations using the evidence they have discovered. The aim will be to create a piece of historical fiction about Shanghai that they will present to their peers in the last week of term.

The trip will take place during the school day, and students should arrive at school at the usual time. They will be transported to and from each location by bus, and will return to school before 3.35pm, ready to take their usual transport home, or to attend their usual ECA. The trips are part of the curriculum and no extra cost is involved.

Students should wear their school uniform, and bring a coat and/or sunhat. They should also bring a small backpack containing pens, pencils, a clipboard for writing on and their iPad. There may not be time to buy lunch, so students should bring a packed lunch.
