Starters: Times Tables



Play rock paper scissors with a family member using your **times table list**.



Draw and colour a picture. Hide your **times table questions and answers** inside your picture.



Make **times table matching cards** and time how long it takes for you to match them. Try to beat your time.



Create your own **times table game** using your times table list.

Main Course – you **MUST** do these every week:

- Reading- 3 times per week
- Spellings- see blue spelling book
- Times Tables
- Mathematics
- Reading Eggs

- Everyone **must** finish the main course every week. Work must be completed by Tuesday.
- Dessert projects are optional. If you have completed it, you will be asked to present your work to your teachers and peers.
- If you are feeling *extra* hungry, you can order from the starters. Each dish has a difficulty rating. The more chilies, the more *challenging* the task!
- Why not spend some time tackling some of the family side dishes? Time spent as a family is important and you can learn together whilst having fun.
