Some parents may have seen an alert from the American Embassy regarding threats to teachers at international schools. Whilst there is no specific threat to our schools in Qatar, we have taken advice and the opportunity to review our security measures at the school. The Nord Anglia Education Head of Health and Safety has been in school this week and has been helping us to enhance the safety plan for staff, students and visitors to the school. We would like to take this opportunity to remind you of some of our security arrangements and to seek your support in helping our security guards fulfil their duties. We ask parents to drive slowly outside the school and park with sensitivity towards others, keeping exits and pavements clear at all times. All visitors entering the site must present photo identification (Qatar ID Card, or Passport) and collect a Visitor Badge. Please make sure you wear this so that it can be seen by staff at all times. For those who have been into school recently, you may have noticed the new glass wall that is being erected in the reception area. We expect this to be complete over the weekend along with a new reception desk to follow. Visitors will not be allowed to go around the school unless previously authorised by a member of staff. This is the start of a series of measures that will gradually be introduced to ensure that every member of our school community can enjoy their work in a safe and secure environment. The safety of your child is paramount and your cooperation in this is greatly appreciated.

Today, you should receive a letter explaining the development of a new group to replace the former School Advisory Council. From next week, copies of important letters home will be added to the 'Parent Essentials' section of the Newsletter just in case they are lost in the depths of a child's bag.



Schaatsen voor water

Afgelopen week heeft u een e-mail gekregen met daarin de uitleg van het evenement "Schaatsen voor water". De kinderen van groep 3-8 hebben afgelopen zondag een gastles gekregen van een medewerker van Plan Nederland. Er werd veel verteld over wat het belang is van schoon drinkwater en waarom je eigenlijk water nodig hebt, ook op school. De leerkracht van Plan legde uit dat we gaan proberen geld op te halen voor het land Zambia,

waar op veel scholen de kinderen geen toegang hebben tot schoon drinkwater. Veel kinderen waren erg verbaasd om te horen dat veel meisjes daar ook niet eens naar school gaan, omdat ze bijvoorbeeld water moeten halen bij een waterput. Toen werd verteld dat dat vaak is omdat de opleiding van jongens belangrijker wordt gevonden dan voor meisjes, was de verontwaardiging (vooral bij de meisjes!) compleet.

Met het geld dat wij gaan ophalen met onze sponsor-schaatstocht gaat Plan Nederland waterpunten, schooltuintjes en toiletten in scholen financieren.



Tot 1 november kunt u zich aanmelden voor het Schaatsen voor Water. Zo gauw u zich heeft aangemeld, krijgt u een e-mail met uitleg op welke wijze het systeem om te sponsoren werkt. Ook wordt een voorbeeld e-mail meegestuurd, die de kinderen kunnen opsturen naar mensen die ze kennen. We hebben hiervoor gekozen, omdat er op die manier ook een e-mail naar vrienden en familieleden in Nederland gestuurd kan worden. De sponsoren krijgen dan vervolgens een bericht hoeveel rondjes er zijn geschaatst, waarna ze het geld overmaken.
