In *Literacy*, we will be building our comprehension skills and will be further exploring our wordless book 'Journey.'

In *Numeracy*, we will be working with shapes and finding lines of symmetry as well as completing the Numeracy Assessment.

In Science, we will be continuing with our topic of 'Habitats' and will learn about identification keys for various animals.

Our IPC topic is 'Olympics.' We will continue looking at different Olympic Parks and will design our own, thinking about what we need to include to make them successful.

In Art, we will be using clay to recreate the designs of Greek Plates, which we designed in previous lessons.

In ICT, we will start to work on our own Wiki pages about the Olympics.

In PSHE, we will be continuing our new topic of 'Healthy Me.' Last week, we started discussing what is healthy and what the healthy habits we should have. This week, we will continue with these discussions and further explore being healthy.
