



What is Different About Gold?


- 12 months for each of Skill, Service, Physical Recreation

Completing Gold Before You Leave School

By starting in Year 9, students can complete:

- Bronze before the end of Year 10
- 2. **Silver** before GCSE exams in Year 11
- 3. **Gold** before IB exams in Year 13



Plans for Next Year

- Executive Principal's Award

- Silver AJ at end of Year 10
 - Finish Bronze in Spring Term
