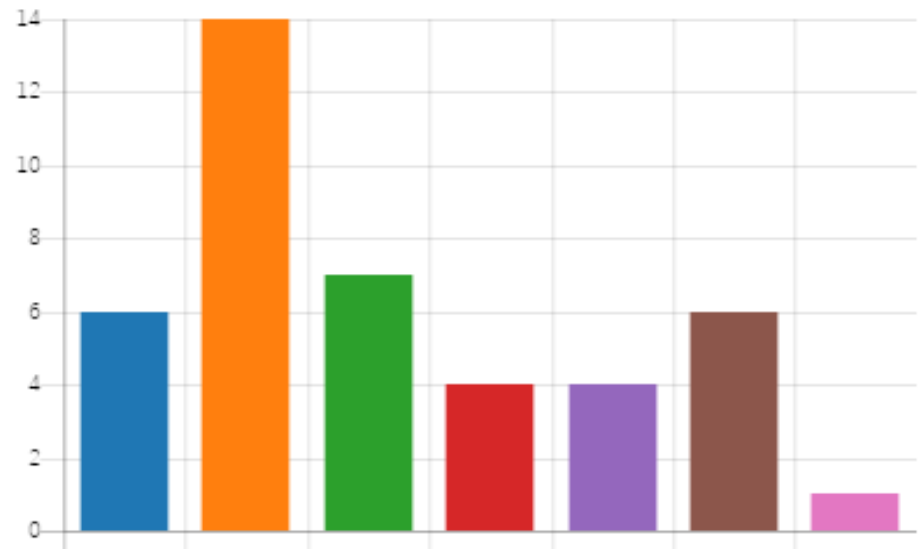

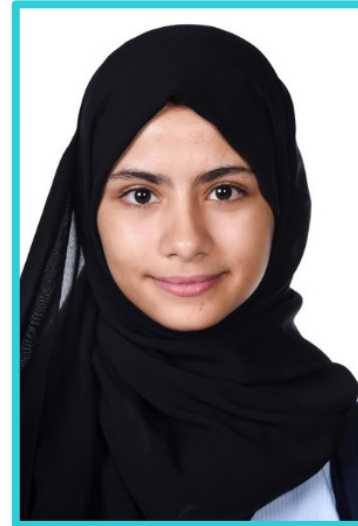

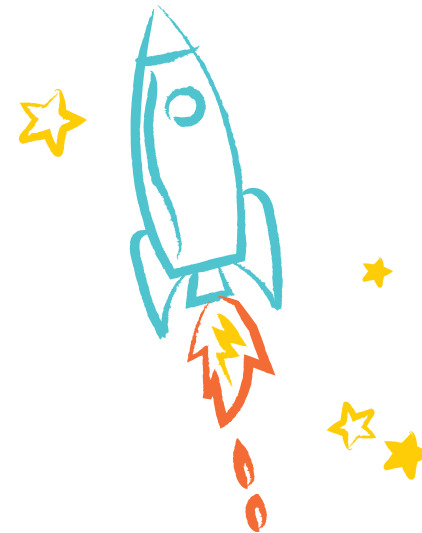

What is Different About Gold?

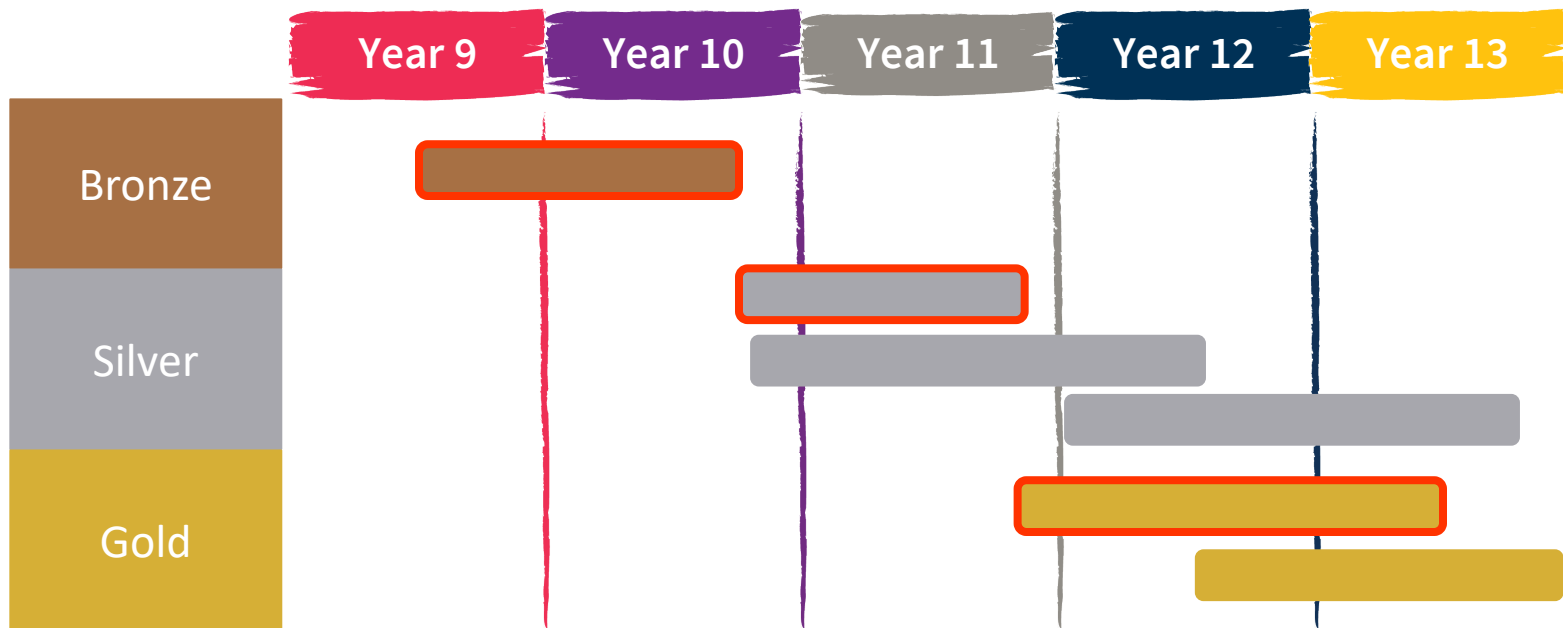
1. 12 months for each of Skill, Service, Physical Recreation

3. Much more student-led
4. Residential Project



Completing Gold Before You Leave School

By starting in Year 9, students can complete:

1. **Bronze** before the end of Year 10
2. **Silver** before GCSE exams in Year 11
3. **Gold** before IB exams in Year 13



Plans for Next Year

1. Executive Principal's Award

- Introduce the idea of service, skill, physical recreation in KS3
- Develop stamina and camp craft

2. Silver AJ at end of Year 10

- Finish Bronze in Spring Term
- Overseas QAJ at end of Summer Term
