

The week ahead in Year 1 (06/05/2018)

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **<u>next week</u>**.

In *Numeracy*, the children will be embedding their knowledge of number bonds up to 20 through reasoning and word problems. They will also be recapping on place value, and how the digits in 2-digit numbers are worth 10s and 1s.

In *Literacy*, the children will be learning about when to use an exclamation mark. They will also be practising the real and nonsense words in preparation for the Phonics screening test.

In *Science*, the children will be starting a new topic of Materials. The children will be identifying different materials and will be identifying their properties.

In *PSHE*, the children will continue their discussion about families and will be drawing pictures of all the family members they can think of.

In *IPC* this week will be the exit point for the theme 'From A to B'. The children are allowed to bring in their bike, scooter or tri-cycle from home as permitted by you. The children will have a morning of fun transportation games using their mode of transport.

In *Art*, the children are going to be creating an envelope city. The children will draw houses on their envelopes and will place the people they create in PSHE inside the envelopes.
