

Chinese First Language Curriculum Overview

Key Stage 3- Year 7

Skills

Students read narratives, descriptions, and arguments comprised of approximately 600 Chinese Characters. They learn to understand the detail and extract key points in texts that contain some unfamiliar vocabulary. They learn to comprehend texts, summarise main ideas in detail and raise questions according to context. They read advertisements, public notices, instructions on food packaging and simple news from newspapers.

Students write essays of 350 Characters with several paragraphs and using appropriate connectives. They demonstrate an appreciation of different writing styles and they also learn to apply correctly the Chinese rhetorical style of writing. Students learn to use a variety of resources to support writing. During their exams, students are expected to write a prose of about 250 Characters in length with reasonable content, linguistic accuracy and proper style.
