


The IB continuum of international education






Alignment of the PYP and MYP





Alignment of the MYP and DP






English A (Language and Literature)	English B
Mother tongue (first language)	Second language
Language course that introduces the critical study and interpretation of written and spoken texts from a wide range of literary and non literary genres.	Language acquisition course for students with some previous experience of learning the language
Main focus: literary and textual analysis, and also the ability to present their ideas effectively.	Main focus: communication and media, global issues, and social relationships
Six (HL) or four (SL) works of literature studied	Two works of literature studied (only for HL)

Figure 2 shows the IB continuum pathways to DP group 5 courses.






Pathway to Diploma Programme subjects—mathematical studies SL, mathematics SL, mathematics HL, and further mathematics HL
