- BSB staff will lead and participate in all activities and will support student learning and involvement, along with staff from Wild China.
- We have high expectations of behaviour and manners in all situations.

- •We will send home the EV5 form you filled in at the beginning of the year by the end of this week. You will need to check the details are accurate.
- •Email a copy of your child's passport as soon as possible. This will support booking procedures. (You can also hand in a hard copy if this is more convenient)
- •PLEASE NOTE students will need to **bring their original passports on the residential**. This is a requirement for all China travel. If you are not going away the weekend before, we are happy to keep them locked away at school ready for Monday morning.
- Specify any food allergies or medical concerns on the contact info form.



- •We have an emergency plan in place. We will contact the SOS International 24 hour hotline and receive immediate advice on the action to take. We will then phone the parents and the school to advise of the situation.
- •We will conduct an **onsite recreational safety visit** in the near future to complete a risk assessment of the location and ensure an action plan is in place incase of natural disasters or travel emergencies.

Electronics

All children will bring their iPads as they will be blogging at some point throughout the week to keep you informed. The adults will have them locked away every evening. If you would prefer, your child could bring along a small digital camera for taking photos and the iPad can be left at the hotel locked away on days they are not blogging. No other electronic devices will be permitted.

We will **provide guidelines** as to when these electronics can/cannot be used and we will expect all students to follow these guidelines.

If guidelines are not followed items will be confiscated until completion of residential.



Room allocations:

Students will choose friends they wish to share with and we will ensure they get to share with someone they have chosen. We will confirm room mates closer to departure. Boys and girls will not be sharing.

Communication

The children will take it in turns to blog about each of our activities throughout each day.

Spending money:

Students can bring up to 200RMB to make small purchases of cultural and tourist items if the occasion arises. All food, snacks drinks are adequately provided for so they won't need to purchase these. Children will hand in their money to adults.

Snacks:

Please do not send any snacks with your children, as stated above, they will be provided.
