Your stay in Florida

Our Venue

Windermere Preparatory School is situated on a green and spacious 48 acre campus on the shore of Lake Cypress. Your child will be competing in state-of-the-art sporting facilities.

In between competitions, your child can rest and recuperate at the Olympic Village located on the school campus. Your child can play with fun, inflatable games, relax under a tent and snack on snow cones and popcorn, all while bonding with fellow Nord Anglia students. This is also where students will re-energize with healthy, nutritious lunches catered by Caterings Best.

Accommodations

The Courtyard Orlando Lake Buena Vista is the official host hotel for the Global Games, The Americas. The hotel, a 15-minute drive southeast from Windermere Preparatory School, has 2 pools, bistro, game room and convenience store, if students want to stock up on snacks or sundries.

Students from all schools will stay at the hotel from Tuesday, November 27th and check out Saturday, December 1st. Your child will share a room with one or two other students and each student will have their own bed. Chaperones will have their own room. We will also have an overflow hotel called the Hyatt Place Orlando due to the Global Games increasing numbers. This hotel is across the street from the Courtyard.

Windermere Preparatory School students will not stay at the hotel. Breakfast is included in the hotel rate and will be served each morning.

Flights

All school flights will be handled and booked by Nord Anglia Education, taking into account costs and timings.

It will be the responsibility of the parents to drive their student to and from their home airport. Chaperones will only allow drop off and pick up of students with a parent present. Please arrange to have at least one parent arrive and pick up at the arranged meeting point.

Transportation in Florida

Nord Anglia Education, including travel between the hotel and Windermere Preparatory School and to all evening activities, will arrange all ground transportation.

Those schools arriving into Orlando International Airport (MCO) will be transported by coach/shuttle to the Courtyard Orlando Lake Buena Vista, Hyatt Place Orlando and returns.

For schools in Florida, we will arrange coach buses from your child's school to the hotel and returns.

Coaches/chaperones

Your child's safety is our highest priority. Throughout the Global Games, your child will be assigned a chaperone to ensure that your child is supervised. Chaperones will be required to attend the entire week of the Global Games. Each chaperone will be in charge of ten students. Chaperones will be appointed by the Athletic Director of each school. Only school staff may chaperone.

Itinerary

The Global Games, The Americas is an exciting 5-day programme packed with sports competitions, activities and the chance to make new friends from Nord Anglia's schools across the region. The programme is designed to enable your child to thrive in an atmosphere of ambition, sportsmanship and teamwork.

Read about the exciting activities we have lined up for your child in this example itinerary.

DAY 1

Arrival and Opening Dinner show at Medieval Times – New Activity!

After registering and settling in to the hotel, your child will have a chance to get to know their fellow Nord Anglia Education students as they relax by the pool. In the evening, we will celebrate the start of the Global Games with a trip to Medieval Times. It is an exciting, family-friendly dinner attraction inspired by an 11th century feast and joust tournament.



DAY 2

Opening of the Global Games and Andretti Indoor Karting and Games

Your child will participate in their first round of games and enjoy their free time between events in our on-campus Olympic Village.

After a full day of competitions, students will head to Andretti Karting and Games to eat dinner and play games, go kart, bowl, play laser tag and more! Nord Anglia Education has reserved the entire facility for our athletes.

DAY 3

The Global Games continues with Mickey's Very Merry Christmas!

After competing in another full day of sports, your child will head to Walt Disney World's Magic Kingdom to eat dinner and enjoy Christmas lights and decor; experience the snowfall on main street; watch amazing fireworks above Cinderella's Castle; and Once Upon a Christmas Parade.



DAY 4

The final day of the Global Games, Awards Ceremony, and Universal Studios!

After a morning of sports competitions, the winners of the Global Games, The Americas will be celebrated at an awards ceremony. Your child will then visit Universal Studios for an afternoon of fun on such rides as Harry Potter and the Escape from Gringotts, Transformer 3D or Terminator 3D.

When Universal Studios closes, your child will head over to the Universal Studio City Walk where they will enjoy dinner at one of the following venues: Jimmy Buffett's Margaritaville, or NBC Sports Grill & Brew, or Red Coconut Club.



DAY 5

Departure

After several action-packed days, students and chaperones will be transported from the hotel to the airport via coach. All departure times will be pre-arranged according to each school's flight time.

Our Global Games Student Registration Package

From hotels to hospitality, we have made sure that your child will be catered to throughout the entire event.

Our Global Games package includes the following:

- Hotel stay from Tuesday through Saturday. (This does not apply to Windermere Preparatory School students)

- Round-trip airport transfers from Orlando Airport (MCO) to Hotel and back. Florida-based students will be transported round trip on coach buses arranged to the Hotel
- Local charter bus package, offering daily bus transportation in Orlando from Hotels to Windermere and evening activities
- Opening & Closing Ceremony entertainment
- Games uniform t-shirts & socks for 3 days, sweatshirt, luggage tag, and swag bag
- Chaperone fee
- Security guards hired each evening at both hotels

- Photography & Videography Coverage
- Nightly entertainment tickets, including Medieval Times, Andretti Karting & Games, Magic Kingdom, and Universal Studios
